WingFoil, Kitesurf & Windsurf Spots in Ibiza (Complete Version)

Cala Conta

Season: ■ Summer & *■ Winter (works all year round)

Working wind directions (updated):

- **SW, N, NE**
- In summer, the southwest (SW) thermic is the most regular and consistent.
- In winter, north or northeast winds bring quality waves.

Conditions:

- In summer, it offers the best thermic winds on the island (relatively flat water).
- In winter, it becomes one of the best wave spots.

Recommended level: ■ Intermediate to Expert

Disciplines: Wing, Wing Foil, Windsurf

Access / Launch:

- Summer: from the rock (technical launch).
- Winter: from the beach.

Additional notes:

- Excellent afternoon thermal wind.
- In winter, beware of waves and currents.
- Technical spot, frequented by experienced riders.

San Antonio – Arenal

Season: ***■** Winter only

Conditions:

- Works well with westerly winds (W).
- Flat water with light chop, ideal for maneuvers.

Recommended level:

- Wing / Foil / Windsurf: All levels.
- Kitesurf: Intermediate to Advanced.

Disciplines: Wing, Foil, Kitesurf, Windsurf

Access / Launch:

- From Arenal beach, easy access.
- Large area to set up gear.

Additional notes:

- Perfect for learning or progressing.
- Wind can be gusty near the coast.
- Nearby services and parking.

San Antonio – Pouet Beach

Season: ***■** Winter only

Conditions:

- Works with northwest (NW) winds.
- Small waves when the wind is strong.
- Small beach, variable sea conditions.

Recommended level:

- Wing: All levels if wind is light / Intermediate—Advanced if strong.
- Foil: Intermediate-Advanced.
- Windsurf: All levels if wind is light.
- Kitesurf: Intermediate-Advanced.

Disciplines: Wing, Foil, Kitesurf, Windsurf

Access / Launch:

- From the small Pouet beach.
- Limited space.
- Experts often continue to Pinet Beach.

Additional notes:

- Ideal for short sessions.
- Becomes technical in strong wind.
- Good starting point for exploring San Antonio Bay.

Pinet Beach

Season: ***■** Winter only

Working wind directions (updated):

- **W, WNW, NW, N** (Does not work with SW).

Conditions:

- Powerful wave spot, considered one of the best in Ibiza.
- With the above directions, it offers large, clean waves.

Recommended level: ■ Experts only

Disciplines: Wing, Wing Foil, Windsurf (kite access only from other spots).

Access / Launch:

- Wing / Foil / Windsurf: from rock or small beach.
- Kitesurf: cannot launch directly here; must come from Pouet or Arenal.

Additional notes:

- The most radical spot in San Antonio.
- Limited space for rigging.
- Ideal for wave riding with foil or windsurf.

Cala Martina (Santa Eulalia)

Season: ***■** Winter

Conditions:

- Works with southwesterly winds (SW).
- Flat water, ideal for kitesurf freestyle.
- Light chop when the wind gets stronger.

Recommended level:

- Kitesurf: Intermediate—Advanced.
- Wing Foil: All levels (■■ shallow areas).
- Windsurf: All levels.

Disciplines: Kitesurf, Wing Foil, Windsurf

Access / Launch:

- From the small Cala Martina beach.
- Limited space.
- Know the shallow zones before riding.

Additional notes:

- Excellent for freestyle and technical training.
- Easy access, parking, and nearby facilities.

Es Codolar

Season: ■ Summer & *■ Winter (mainly summer)

Conditions:

- E-SE winds: flat water.
- SW wind: generates larger waves and more technical conditions.

Recommended level:

- Wing / Foil / Windsurf: All levels (E-SE) / Intermediate-Advanced (SW).
- Kitesurf: Forbidden.

Disciplines: Wing, Foil, Windsurf

Access / Launch:

- From the pebble beach.
- Easy entry but rocky (water shoes recommended).

Additional notes:

- Very consistent summer thermals.
- Great spot for wingfoil in summer.
- Respect restricted zones near the airport.

Es Cavallet

Season: ■ Summer & *■ Winter

Conditions:

- Works with northeast (NE) and east (E) winds.
- Best wind: NE (cleaner and steadier).
- E wind brings choppy, cross-onshore waves.
- In winter, strong NE produces great surfable waves.

Recommended level:

- Kitesurf: Intermediate-Advanced.
- Wing Foil: Intermediate—Advanced (■■ shallow zones).
- Windsurf: All levels.

Disciplines: Kitesurf, Wing Foil, Windsurf

Access / Launch:

- From the sandy beach.
- In summer, one of the few authorized kite spots.

Additional notes:

- Great waves for foil and kite jumps.
- Check the bottom due to shallow rocks.
- Contact locals for updated conditions.

Playa d'en Bossa (Embossa)

Season: ■ Mainly summer

Conditions:

- Works with east (E) and east-northeast (ENE) winds.
- Flat or lightly choppy water.
- With strong winds, large waves perfect for jumping or surfing.

Recommended level:

- Wing / Windsurf: All levels.
- Kitesurf: Intermediate—Advanced (off-season only).

Disciplines: Wing, Windsurf, Kitesurf (off-season only).

Access / Launch:

- From the sandy beach.
- Kite allowed only from the mid-north section (towards Figueretas).
- ■ Forbidden near the airport.

Additional notes:

- Perfect for freeride sessions in summer.
- Great waves with strong easterly winds.
- Avoid crowded areas and rough seas if inexperienced.
